Both the man and the baby survived the accident with wounds and bruises. A year later, another baby from a fourth-floor window found his way on top of this same man. On this second instance, the man was doing his job as a street sweeper when the baby fell.

In 1937 and 1938, Detroit had a population of around 1.5 million people so two babies landing on the same person on separate occasions is highly improbable.
