ROLE-PLAY SITUATION: ordering food at a fast food restaurant

Instructor directions: The student has indicated that she wishes to do a **ordering food at a fast food restaurant** role-play. Students have been instructed to prepare for the role-play, but will most likely have trouble doing the role-play smoothly on their first attempt. Below is a model conversation. Variations are acceptable. The main point being is to ensure that the student's message is understood. For ordering food at a fast food restaurant, work with the student and repeat the role-play as many times until the student can do it reasonably fluently. Three fast food scenarios have been prepared- one for each of the possible study abroad destinations the student will go to. Find out which destination the student is heading for, and choose the appropriate role-play. Point out that fast food language tends to reflect the situation- it is "fast" and simple, with a minimum degree of politeness.

For students going to New Zealand, use the following role-play:
