ROLE-PLAY SITUATION: ordering food at a restaurant

Instructor directions: The student has indicated that she wishes to do a **ordering food at a restaurant** role-play. Students have been instructed to prepare for the role-play, but will most likely have trouble doing the role-play smoothly on their first attempt. Below is a model conversation. Variations are acceptable. The main point being is to ensure that the student's message is understood. Work with the student and repeat the role-play as many times until the student can do it reasonably fluently.



Server: Good evening. My name is ______ and I will be your server tonight. Can I get you something to drink before you order your meal?

Student: Yes, please. Could I have a coke, please?

Server: Certainly. I'll be back shortly with your drinks and to take your order.

(a few minutes later)

Server: Are you ready to order?

Student: Yes, I'll have the ______ and the ______.

Server: Certainly. Anything for dessert?

Student: No, thanks.

Server: Anything else?

Student: A glass of iced water, please.

Server: Sure. I'll be back with your meals soon.

Student: Thank you.
