## **ROLE-PLAY SITUATION:** how to make a popular Japanese dish

**Instructor directions:** The student has indicated that she wishes to do a **how to make a popular Japanese dish** role-play. Students have been instructed to prepare for the role-play, but will most likely have trouble doing the role-play smoothly on their first attempt. Below is a model conversation. Variations are acceptable. The main point being is to ensure that the student's message is understood. Work with the student and repeat the role-play as many times until the student can do it reasonably fluently. Points to note:

- You may wish to check to see if students know these food preparation words or not.
- Encourage the student to use sequence adverbs (First, Next, Then, After that, Finally). Explain that we use these words to help make the explanation and understanding of the process easier.
- Also explain that when explaining a process such as making a dish, we use combine sequence adverbs and the imperative form of the verb (e.g. First, cut the meat..)
