5. Let the student read the short passage below for 20-30 seconds silently.
6. After the given time above, ask the student to read the passage aloud.

- 8. For the first three questions, the student may look at the Speaking Test material.**
- 9. Before you proceed to the 4<sup>th</sup> question, you may inform your student to close the material so he/she can focus on the discussion.**
- 10. Give a short feedback to the student (positive and give points for improvement).**
- 11. If there's still time, you may do a free conversation related to the topic featured in this speaking test. :)**
