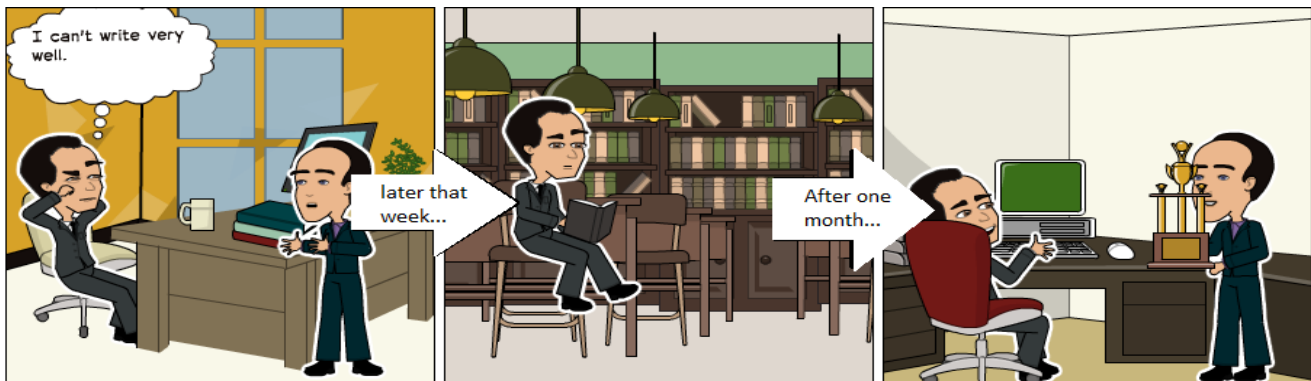


PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS:
