adj. swift	quick; fast	Thank you so much for your swift response.
n. assistance	the act of helping	We will send assistance as soon as possible.
n. emergency	a situation that needs immediate action	This is the emergency hotline.
v. past: instructed instruct	to give an order or command	We'll instruct everyone to leave the building in an orderly manner.
